What's in the deal?

- National security – commitments on safeguards and redress for citizens
- Company requirements – timeline to respond to complaints, dispute procedures, onward transfer to 3rd parties
- Legal basis and enforcement – based on commitment letters, increased supervision, annual review

EU Data Protection Regulation

- **Defining data:** broader definition of personal data
- **Data flows:** similar mechanisms to now; limit on third country access request
- **Control:** document, audit, EU access requests, security, impact assessment, vendor flow down, consent to change vendor
- **Handling 'events':** assist data subject requests; breach notification
- **Liability:** joint liability; huge increase in fines (2-4% revenue)
- **End of contract:** delete data

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Network and Information Security Directive

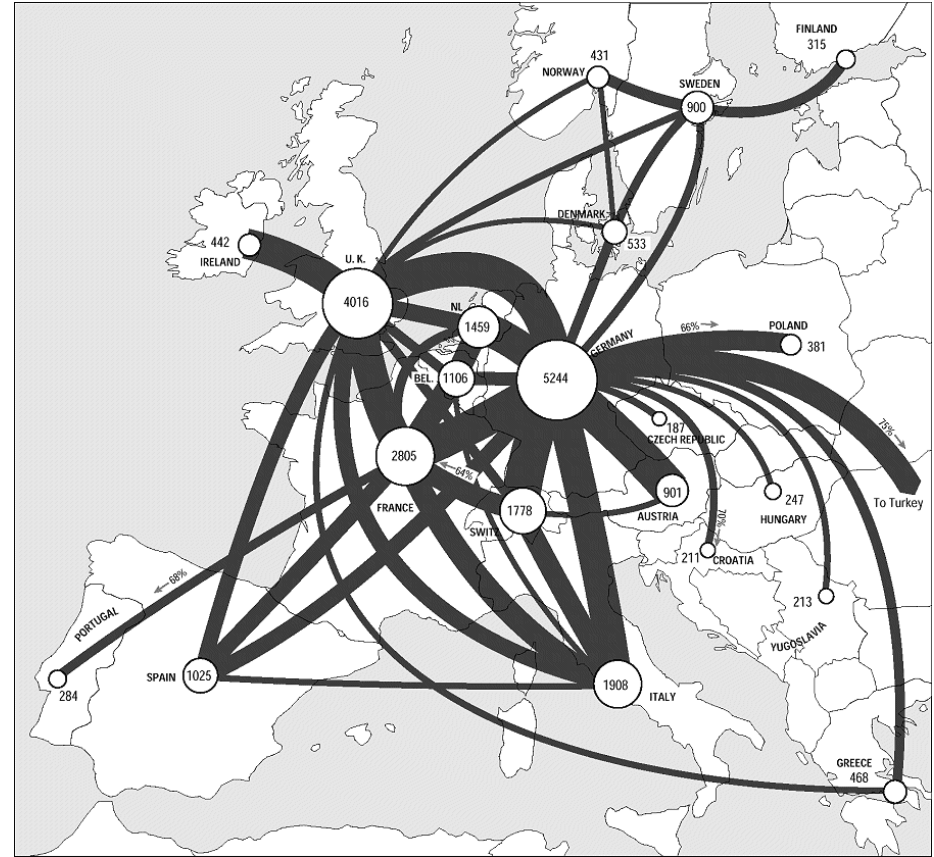

Impact on cloud providers

- **Security measures:** MSs and ENISA encourage standards, EC harmonisation
- **Incident notification:** to competent authority (and critical sector customers)
- **Oversight:** assessment and remedies
- **Jurisdiction:** EU head office
- **Critical sector customer obligations'** flow down
- **Implementation:** 21 month deadline
